## Resolution Rally Activity

**Directions/Purpose:** The objective of the Resolution Rally is to have service unit teams and leaders acknowledge tasks or activities they would like to accomplish in their respective roles before the end of the membership year. By writing it down you are reaffirming your commitment to complete your identified task. Keep the newsprint and bring it to future meetings to see what has been accomplished and what remains. Send out a communication to see if anyone needs help. The important point is to not forget our goals.

**Service unit leader meeting:** the manger will display the appropriate number of newsprint and ask team members and leaders to record unfinished tasks. Once this is completed ask, "What has hindered you from completing this task? What are you going to do differently to finish it and why it is important to you or your troop?" This activity can also be applied at the troop level, in many ways, but here are three examples 1). Administrative items the leader must complete (i.e. turning in their financial report), 2) activities or girl/adult planning and 3) setting cookie goals.

### Supplies & Set Up:

- Display 5 sheets of newsprint (or more if needed) label each sheet for the remaining months in your service unit or troop.
- Markers
